

NO. 5002 COMMUNICABLE DISEASE - STUDENT

- 1.0 Information concerning a student with a communicable disease should be referred or reported to the Office of the Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services or designated personnel. This information may come from the affected individual, a private physician, the State Health Department, or any person with knowledge of the particular case.
- 2.0 The Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services or designated personnel shall verify the information and contact, as necessary, the city, county, or state health departments, medical personnel or other appropriate parties to determine the extent and severity of the illness.
- 3.0 Depending upon the information gained, the Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services or designated personnel will decide whether it is appropriate for the student to be in contact with members of the college community.
 - 3.1 Decision-making criteria will include
 - 3.1.1 The actual or potential threat of communicability to the college community.
 - 3.1.2 The degree to which the disease will pose a life-threatening risk to the college community.
- 4.0 The Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services or designated personnel shall notify the student of his or her restrictions and the process by which the restrictions will be removed.
- 5.0 The Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services or the designated personnel shall maintain confidential all records concerning the case.
