

TITLE: ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE NO. 5011 COURSE SUBSTITUTIONS IN A DEGREE PLAN

- 1.0 FOLLOW CURRICULUM PATTERN
 - Degree seeking students should follow the curriculum pattern for the major academic area they select as it is outlined in the Catalog.
- 2.0 COURSE SUBSTITUTIONS IN DEGREE PLAN REQUIREMENTS
 - 2.1 In special cases, students may be permitted to modify their associate degree or certificate program by substituting a course of related subject matter for a required course.
 - 2.2 Substitution for any required course in a degree plan requires approval by the student's assigned faculty advisor and division dean.
 - 2.3 A Degree Advisement Worksheet indicating the course substitution must be signed by the faculty advisor and division dean and submitted to Graduation, Employment, and Transfer Services.
